Name of Nursing School

1. Is the nursing program approved/accredited?

State level Yes/No

(The Washington State Nursing Care Quality Assurance Commission. All nursing programs must be approved by NCQAC)

National level Yes/No

(Not required but highly recommended, both are equally desirable)

A. CCNE – Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (BSN and graduate programs)

or

B. NLNAC – National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission (Diploma, ADN, BSN and graduate programs)

2. **What** is the application process?

3. **What** are your admission criteria?

4. **What** is the admissions deadline?

5. **WHAT** are the graduation rates?

(What percentage of students entering the program graduated from the nursing program within the expected time?)

6. **WHAT** is the licensure test (RN-NCLEX) pass rate?

(How many of the students sitting for the RN exam to become registered nurses actually passed the first time taking the exam? Minimum NCQAC requirement is 80%)

7. **HOW** did your students rate their satisfaction with the program?
