Criteria for application: Preference is given to diverse groups currently under-represented in the health professions, rural students and 1st generation college students. Must be a high school junior or senior at the time of application.

Students will:

- 🏥 Explore health and social service careers in 4 - 6 weeks
- 🏥 Commit 20 hours per week for 4 - 6 weeks
- 🏥 Receive minimum wage per hour
- 🏥 Gain valuable insight into a future in health care

Students who are chosen cannot participate in a second summer internship program that coincides with the HOPE internship. Summer jobs are allowed though the prime internship times are Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.
