Spreadsheet Notes

This spreadsheet was created to be a general guide to support potential nursing students in mapping out their nursing education. It is reviewed and updated twice a year (generally in late spring and mid-fall) and may not contain the most up-to-date information. For the most up-to-date information on each program, you must visit the program website.
Nursing programs have additional requirements to apply. These requirements can vary from program to program. Be sure to carefully review the application requirements for any program you want to apply to.

Some additional requirements can include the following (this is not a complete list of all possible requirements). Visit the program website for more detailed information. - Completion of a Pre-Admission Exam (PAX Exam), or the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS). Some programs require a specific PAX Exam or TEAS Test score. Visit the program

website for more detailed information.

- An active, unencumbered Washington State Nursing Assistant license.

- Proof of current immunization status: Vaccinations must be up-to-date and current.

- A background check performed by the Washington State Patrol and with a "No Record On File" report with the Department of Social and Health Services. (All nursing students are

required to complete a background check. The background check is usually completed through the nursing program you are applying to.)

- American Heart Association CPR for the Health Care Provider. This includes adult, child, and infant, under the guidelines of the American Heart Association. Online CPR courses are not

accepted.

- Students can be required to carry personal health/medical insurance throughout their clinical rotations.

• College-level skills in English and math (eligibility for courses numbered 100 or higher) are required before registering for the the college-level nursing prerequisite courses listed on this spreadsheet. Students may need to complete additional prerequisite coursework if they do not yet qualify to register for these college level courses.

• Courses highlighted in yellow are considered core prerequisite courses for most (but
