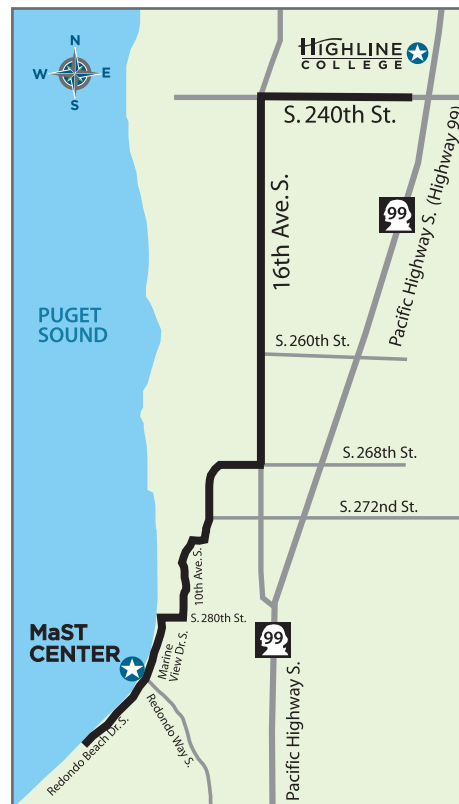

CAMPUS PARKING INFORMATION
